To All Senior Class Parents and Students:

I would like to welcome all senior class students and their parents to the spring semester of their culminating year at Thomas A. Edison Career & Technical Education High School. This can be your best, most exciting and fastest semester yet! In what will seem like the blink of an eye you will be wearing your gowns and tuxedos at the prom, followed by your caps and gowns and walking across the stage to receive your high school diploma.

The following are important reminders and information that seniors need to know for the spring term.

1. This year's Senior Class dues are **\$245.00**. A deposit of \$135.00 was due in November. The remaining balance must be paid in full no later than Friday March 2, 2018. The class dues cover the cost of many of the senior activities; Yearbook, Senior BBQ, cap and gown, diploma case, graduation venue and programs.
2. This year's prom will be held at Crest Hollow Country Club in Woodbury, NY on Wednesday June 6, 2018 from 7:00 pm – 12:00 am. Each ticket will cost **\$120.00**. A deposit of \$60.00 is required to guarantee a ticket. The deadline to guarantee a ticket is Friday April 13, 2018 (unless tickets are sold out earlier) and the last day to pay in full for all tickets is Friday May 4, 2018.
3. There will be two graduation rehearsals. The first is on Tuesday June 19 at 8:00 am and the second rehearsal is scheduled for Thursday June 21 at 8:00 am. Caps and gowns will be distributed after the first rehearsal.
4. Graduation will be held at Hofstra University Mack Sports Complex on Monday June 25, 2018. Students should arrive at Hofstra by 9:00 am. The ceremony will begin at 9:30 am.
5. Yearbooks will be distributed at the Senior BBQ on Thursday June 21, and diplomas will be given to graduating seniors on the last day of school, Tuesday June 26.
6. The Senior Trip to **Busch Gardens** is scheduled for April 27, 2018. All forms, permission slips and payments must be received by March 9 in order to attend. In addition, no student will be allowed to go on the trip unless his/her senior dues are paid in full. Each student must have passed all his/her classes in the 2<sup>nd</sup> marking period and be in good standing with the Dean's and Attendance Offices. Every student going on the trip is required to attend a pre-trip meeting in the school auditorium. As per all trip documents, all students' bags will be searched by chaperones prior to leaving the school on April 27.
